

# Terms and Conditions

By registering to participate in the **WDF 2019** (the “Event”), the Participant agrees to the following terms and conditions. Registrations for the Event can exclusively be concluded through this online registration tool.

The organiser of the Event is **Frauscher Sensortechnik GmbH** (“Frauscher”).

## Substitution Policy

Substitution of the Participant is possible at any time without any extra fees if the Participant informs Frauscher at least three days prior to the Event to make arrangements for the substitute.

## Cancellation Policy

In case of a cancellation in written form received by Frauscher until 20 May 2019, the Participant will receive a full refund of the paid Event fee. In case of cancellations which are received by Frauscher later than 20 May 2019, or if the Participant remains absent on the date of the Event, the full Event fee is payable and may not be refunded.

## Privacy

Frauscher collects, stores and processes the Participant’s personal data in accordance with the applicable data protection regulations, in particular the European General Data Protection. The Participant’s personal data will be used as required for the organisation and administration of the Event, further for providing the Participant with product and/or service information. Should the Participant wish to have details about the use of his personal data or to be removed from Frauscher’s database, he may contact Frauscher as described above.

## Fees and Payment Conditions

Payment must be made by the Participant in Euro at the time of registering unless specifically stated. Payment shall be made free of bank charges without any deduction for discount, by means of bank transfer or credit card.

Payment to attend the Event must be made prior to the Event starting, unless otherwise agreed with Frauscher. Frauscher reserves the right to refuse attendance to the Participant who has not paid in full for his Event fee.

The fee of the Event includes the possibility for the Participant to download speakers’ presentations, access to the conference hall & materials, catering and the gala dinner. Each Participant will bear its own accommodation and travel expenses. Upon request by a Participant, Frauscher may negotiate and offer favourable hotel rates.

## Photography and Recording

The Participant agrees that Frauscher arranges for photographs and/or video footage (including audio) to be taken at the Event and used for promotional purposes free of charge. This may include printed documents or media, editorial coverage, advertising press and use on the internet.

## Liability

Frauscher refuses liability if the Event gets cancelled or postponed for reasons beyond Frauscher's reasonable control resulting from Force Majeure, governmental regulation, fire, war, terrorist activity or civil commotion. Frauscher refuses liability if the Participant is unable to attend the Event due to adverse weather conditions or any travel disruption.

Frauscher reserves the right to postpone the Event to a later date or make changes to the location and/or confirmed speakers. If the Participant decides to cancel its participation because the event got postponed the Participant will receive a full refund of the paid Event fee.

These Terms and Conditions may be updated at any time at Frauscher's sole discretion and shall be governed and interpreted in accordance with the laws of Austria. Disputes shall be exclusively settled by the materially and locally competent court for Frauscher.
